On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after it's name. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form. The Kennel Club Authority to Compete number (for dogs registered and resident outside the UK) must be stated or the entry will be returned. PLEASE CHECK ALL DETAILS BEFORE POSTING.

With an interest in Peter's 'Norcairn' affix, I have had the absolute pleasure in being involved in making up three Boston Terrier champions, as well as two French Bulldog champions, who are my only other dog passion. Having awarded CC's in both Boston Terrier and French Bulldogs, any CC appointment is flattering enough, but to be offered an appointment by the parent club of the breed for only my second appointment is an absolute honour and privilege and I am truly thankful for those members who voted for me.

Special Award Classes Mrs Helen Gracie (Summergate)

I have owned, bred and judged Red Setters for over 30 years, and have made up a champion and bred a number of CC and RCC winners. I have judged enough dogs to be put forward to award CC's subject to KC approval. I have also owned French Bulldogs for 8 years, have bred five that have gained their stud book numbers. I own a Russian Import that is now a Lux and Irish Champion and is a JW winner and his progeny are also gaining their stud book numbers. I have attended and passed hands on seminars.
