dog show will be lost in Cornwall.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING IDENTIFICATION OF DOGS**

It is a Kennel Club requirement that exhibitors display the exhibit number on their crate, cage, or container at all times.

This is particularly important when cages etc. are not on benches, and at unblended shows.

Each exhibitor is responsible for providing their own cage identification and should note that the original exhibit/bench number card, as provided by the show society, must not be used for this purpose.

It is important to be able to contact exhibitors and identify dogs where a dog may be in distress or where the crate might be blocking a gangway.

## **JUDGES PROFILES –**

### Julie Darby – Incadar

My husband Graham and I had our first dog, a Golden Retriever, in 1987, Bred our first litter in 1990. Our first Large Munsterlander arrived in 1994. We showed and helped at our local Stourbridge ringcraft. I judged Golden Retrievers and Large Munsterlanders at my first judging appointment in 1997. Since then, I have judged numerous times and various breeds of Gundogs all over the country. I have given 5 sets of CC's in Large Munsterlanders and have judged NSDT Retrievers 3 times at Champ shows without tickets. I have judged a Gundog Group and a lovely Limit show. We have made up 3 Show Champion Munsterlanders, one of which we bred ourselves. I am very much looking forward to judging in Cornwall.

### Alison Cooper – Hugared

We got our first Irish Setter in 1993 but didn't start showing until we got our third dog a few years later. Over the past 30 years we have owned 10 Irish and showed 7 of them, achieving stud book numbers for 2 of our boys. I so enjoyed preparing our dogs for the shows that I trained as a groomer. I gave up my role as a Staff Nurse in the NHS and opened my own grooming business which I ran successfully for 14 years before retiring in 2022. I began judging in 2013 focusing on the Irish but have also judged other breeds within the Gundog Group such as Cockers, Labradors, and other Setters. at Open shows across the UK. I am also a committee member of Paignton and District Fanciers Association and very proud to be a part of the team that were a contender for Champ Show of the year at Pawscars. I have passed my A3 assessment for Irish Setters and am keen to progress to awarding CC's in this breed in due course. I am delighted that Cornwall Gundog Club have asked me to judge at their Open Show and I thank the Officers and Committee for this honour.

## DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the Rules of the governing body recognised by The Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class i.e. 8<sup>th</sup>. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering in Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value. If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options: -

- (1) Withdrawal The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations F(1)19.
- (2) Transfer
  - a. If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height or, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
  - b. For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior Class, which is over age but under twelve calendar months of age, eighteen calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling Class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling Class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
  - c. For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight, or height.
  - d. If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**MINOR PUPPY** - For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**PUPPY** - For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**JUNIOR** - For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**YEARLING** - For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**SPECIAL YEARLING** - For dogs of six and not exceeding twenty-four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

**GRADUATE** - For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or only from those dogs which have received a first prize in a breed class at the show. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be declared.

four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**POST GRADUATE** - For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**LIMIT** - For dogs which have not become show Champions under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

**OPEN** - For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

**VETERAN** - For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

**SPECIAL VETERAN 7-9 years** - For dogs of not less than seven years of age and not over nine years of age on the first day of the show.

**SPECIAL VETERAN** - For dogs of 10 years of age and over on the first day of the show.

**SPECIAL CHAMPION** - For dogs which have become a Champion, Show Champion or Field Trial Champion under Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club – dogs must compete in breed or AVNSC classes to be eligible for Best in Show.

**BRACE** - For two exhibits (either sex or mixed) of one breed belonging to the same exhibitor, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than Brace.

**GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME** - For dogs that have achieved their GCDS Bronze Award Certificate or above.

**SHOW CERTIFICATE OF MERIT or SHOW CERTIFICATE OF EXCELLENCE** - For dogs which have been confirmed a Show Certificate of Merit or Show Certificate of Excellence winner - dogs must compete in breed or AVNSC classes to be eligible for Best in Show.

**SPECIAL WORKING GUNDOG** - For dogs which have won prizes and awards in recognised competition at Gundog Working Test or having gained their Show Gundog Qualifier or a Gundog Working Certificate.

**IMPORTED BREED REGISTER** - For breeds confined to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class, with the winning dog being eligible for Best in Group / Best Puppy in Group or Best in Show / Best Puppy in Show as relevant. Such breeds may be entered into Imported Breed Register classes and/or Any Variety or Stakes classes, with the exception of **AVNSC** classes, for which they are not eligible.

**NATIVE VULNERABLE BREEDS** - For gundog breeds as per Kennel Clubs yearly list.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The show will open at 8.00 am.
2. Dogs will be received at any time, but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. Judging will commence at 9.00 am.
4. The show will be unbenched. Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed. The show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. The use of cooking stoves within the confines of the show is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.

6. **YEARLY MEMBERSHIP** - £3.00 Single - £4.00 Joint - £1.00 Junior

**Entry fees per dog per class** - £4.00 Members - £5.50 Non-Members – NFC Free. Make all cheques or postal orders payable to “Cornwall Gundog Club” or Bank Transfer quoting Name and Breed, e mail secretary for bank details. **Catalogues** £3.00 with entries.

**Catalogue advertisements:** £5.00 full page or £3.00 half page – copy with entry subject to space available. **Class Rosettes:** £3.00 a set. **Special Rosettes:** £2.50 each for BOB – RBOB – BOS – BPIB - BVIB only.

Schedules will be posted, e mailed or given out at other shows. Entries can be made online by emailing entry form to the Secretary and BACS the fees to Cornwall Gundog account.

7. Prize money on offer at this show is: BIS - £20, RBIS - £15, 3<sup>rd</sup> BIS - £10, 4<sup>th</sup> BIS - £5. BPIS - £20, RBPIS - £15, 3<sup>rd</sup> BPIS - £10, 4<sup>th</sup> BPIS - £5. BVIS - £15, RBVIS - £10. Best RBOBIS - £15.

8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries.

9. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the show are not eligible for exhibition.

10. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.

11. Best Puppy in Show

Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified Puppy or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register Puppy. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it may, at the discretion of the judge, be awarded Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it may, at the discretion of the judge, be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed, Best in Group and Best in Show respectively.

12. Best in Show

The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and has been declared Best of Breed, Best Any Variety Not Separately Classified or Best Any Variety Imported Breed Register.

Best of Breed - Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed may be declared

but 13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.

14. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.

15. All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

16. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

#### **17. DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS**

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and The Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at Kennel Club licensed events.

When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.

The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.

Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free-flowing air around the dog.

When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.

Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

**WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**

18. Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under The Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any show licensed by The Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the show.

19. Not for Competition: Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered. 20. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the Board of The Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.

## **REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B) 1.**

These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42. (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained thereat. (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42. 2. (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show. (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition. 3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except: - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee. (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed. (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown. Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive. 4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis. 5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf. 6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
