

INTRODUCING YOUR JUDGE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW MR PETER CLIFTON (Joseter)

It's long been said Lady Luck plays a part in everyone's life story and for myself truer words could not be said. My first involvement in dogs was my step dad's racing greyhound that always came second until he sold it, after which it won every race. In 1951 I handled for the very first time with my parents Willowbeach kennel prefix, and the first dog I handled to his title was born in 1958 who also became my first of any best in show winners, at the Cardigan Welsh Corgi Ass National annual speciality shows.

On leaving school I was allowed to follow my dream and left for my first job junior kennel boy in Alsatian and Bedlington kennels at Kenfield Hall, Petham, nr Canterbury. It was at this time my ambition to become a professional handler but sadly being a junior kennel boy I visualised this would never happen in this employment, so I moved on to Frimley and poodle kennels and after two years became a self taught poodle groomer and handler. Two years later saw me back home and I became a self employed groomer, trading under the name Peter's Poodle Parlour.

The Joseter prefix was registered with the Kennel Club in the 1960s and today can be found in pedigrees around the world.

Its long been acknowledged that national speciality shows, with the largest of quality entries, sets the standard for coming years. Since winning the first Cardigan national in the 60s I have handled twenty two national best in show winners, seven best of opposites and twelve reserve c.c winners. I also feel extremely proud to be the only person in Cardigans to have handled, to best in show, exhibits at the U.K and American Cardigan national specialities. I can also add best in show at the Boston Terrier Club ch show to my list of big wins.

My judging career started in 1959 and my first C.C appointment was in 1975. Today I am approved to award C.Cs in six breeds, Cardigan and Pembroke Welsh Corgi, Boston Terrier, German Spitz and Norwegian Buhunds.

From my years in the dogs I have benefited from the knowledge of so many, Today I try to share this with others, by my example, as a breeder, exhibitor, handler and judge, trusting that this may help our wonderful breeds for the next generation. To those starting out today the best advice I can offer, its not about what records you hold today but what you walk into the ring with tomorrow.

I regard judging not as a right but a privilege that exhibitors pay hard earned money to show under, and I will always endeavour to judge to a standard that makes my appraisal of exhibits highly valued, whether one wins or not.

Boston Terriers came into my life in 1979 and while owned by Anne under her Antrix label, they are all so much part of my every day life, I look forward to this appointment and being with you all once again.

If the registration or transfer of ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by The Kennel Club. Puppies under 6 months of age on the first day of the Show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after it's name. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form. The Kennel Club Authority to Compete number (for dogs registered and resident outside the UK) must be stated or the entry will be returned. PLEASE CHECK ALL DETAILS BEFORE POSTING.
